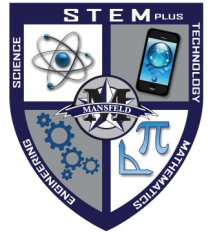

Mr. Koland's 7th grade Social Studies classes studied the Industrial Revolution last quarter. To more deeply understand the concepts and experiences of that time period, students engaged in a model-building project using the STEM practices of **developing models** and **using tools strategically**. They used assembly-line principles to construct boxes that became the building materials for 3-D models of Mansfeld. Check out one of the great models they collaboratively designed and built!

October 27-November 10

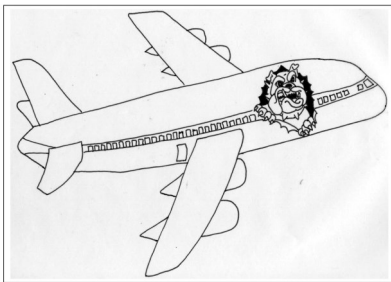
Students in grades 6 and 7 are participating in TUSD's [Family Life Curriculum](#) during their Science period. There are separate classes for boys and girls at each grade level.
