Dear Mansfeld Families,

Welcome to the 2023-24 school year! I am honored to return as your principal and am privileged to continue to work alongside our highly qualified and dedicated staff, our amazing students, and our wonderful and supportive parents and guardians as we pursue our quest to "Be the Best!".

Last year was a building year. We re-introduced many events at Mansfeld to help our students grow and thrive, such as Awards Night, Bulldog Saturdays, Quarterly Reward Field Trips, In-Person Concerts, The DC Field Trip, Benchmark Celebrations, and many other events. Our focus last year was on Building Brick by Brick, and this year our theme is Stronger Together. This year, we will also be supporting our students' success socially & emotionally with a districtwide program called Character Strong.

As your principal, I will lead each day with integrity and excellence to ensure that Mansfeld is a safe, enjoyable, and enriching educational experience for all our students. While our staff will do everything they can here at Mansfeld, education is a partnership and as partners we share the responsibility for your child's success. We ask for your teamwork and support by ensuring that your student(s):

- 1. Attends school daily, arrives on time and is ready for the day's learning experiences.
- 2. Completes all homework assignments given by teachers.
- 3. Shares school experiences with you so that you are aware of their school life.
- 4. Informs you if they need additional support in any area or subject.
- Knows that you expect them to succeed in school.

Registration & Schedule Pickup

July 25th, 26th & 27th

9:00-11:00AM & 1:00-3:00PM

8th Grade Students- Tuesday, July 25th - 9:00-11:00AM & 1:00-3:00PM

7th Grade Students- Wednesday, July 26th -9:00-11:00AM & 1:00-3:00PM

6th Grade Students- Thursday, July 27th -9:00-11:00AM & 1:00-3:00PM

All returning and/or new students who completed their registration in the spring will need to come to school on their designated date to pick up their schedule and get their ID picture taken.

Returning students **who did not** complete their registration in the spring will need to come to school and complete their registration on the designated date. These students will pick up their schedule on the first day of school, August 3rd, 2023.

New students to Mansfeld **who did not** complete their registration in the spring will need to come in and complete their registration on their designated date (see above). You must provide:

- Photo identification with current address.
- Proof of residency with current address.
- An original birth certificate.
- Immunization records.

Information about school uniforms, iPads, lunch, parental access, the PTSO (Parent-Teacher-Student Organization), tax credit donations, after school programs, sports, and clubs will also be available at this time. In addition, yearbooks may also be ordered during registration.

On all three days there will be a morning session from 9:00AM-11:00AM and an afternoon session from 1:00PM -3:00PM in the cafeteria/auditorium.

New Student Orientation

We will be hosting a new student orientation for all students who are new to Mansfeld on Friday, July 28th from 9:00-11:00AM. This orientation will consist of a school tour and informational breakout sessions. Parents are encouraged to attend with their child. Any school questions will be addressed at this orientation. Students and parents are able to walk their child's schedule after the conclusion of orientation.

First Day of School for Students

The first day of school for students will begin on Thursday, August 3rd at 8:43AM. Please make sure your student arrives on time and in school uniform.

Arrival/Dismissal Times

Arrival- Our school day begins at 8:43AM every day. Please be sure to have your child/children here on time. The Mansfeld campus will open at 8:00AM. There will be no student supervision prior to 8:00AM.

Important: In the mornings to assist with student safety and supervision, students being dropped off or walking to school will need to enter the campus through the Tunnel by the West parking lot. The East gate by the U of A Rec. Center **will not** be open in the mornings for drop off.

Bus Riders & Bike Riders: Students using TUSD bus transportation are scheduled to arrive on campus no later than 8:30AM. These students and our bicycle riders will enter through the South Gate by the Bus Bay. Please never drop off your child in the Bus Bay. The Bus Bay is for busses only.

Dismissal: Our school day dismisses at 3:50PM on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. On Wednesday, students will be dismissed at 2:50PM. During dismissal, the East gate by the Rec Center **will** be open.
