- Cookie Fundraiser- cookies were delivered today, Stu Co raised \$456

### **III. Discussion/Action**

- Tax Credit Balances
  - C. Davidson received a full list of all tax credit balances and shared out the update. Nathan's Kids total is \$7,983 (in undesignated).
  - As of April 1st, we have \$30,747.89 in Undesignated Tax Credit funds. Taking out the Nathan's Kids total, that leaves \$22,639.89 in Undesignated funds.
- Scholastic Book Fair
  - Stu Co and D. Gutierrez are interested in hosting a Scholastic/Discovery book fair. She suggested having it during a time when parents would likely be in the building (i.e.- PTC week). C. Davidson shared info from A. Wilson Anderson that there are minimum guidelines for supervision, etc from TUSD. She suggested pairing with PTSO to staff it next year.
- Bylaws
  - Changes were proposed last semester, but C. Davidson can't find the notes for proposed changes. We will look at the revisions at the next meeting for approval
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade End of Year Activities
  - Promotion
    - K. Martinez will be putting together a committee to help make decisions regarding the event. It will be in the gym at Catalina HS at 6pm. Mansfeld will have to take over chairs and a small stage.
  - Dance
    - May 15<sup>th</sup>, 6-8 pm. 8<sup>th</sup> grade team will look at basing participation on behavior
    - Last year they had a lot of donations but will need to ask for money/donations to make it happen this year.
    - Stu Co will give \$700. Asking PTSO for additional money (120 people)
      - \$425 for 2 hours of the photo booth
      - \$450 for DJ (M. Francis' father)
      - \$ for red carpet, popcorn machine, food, drinks, decorations (movie themed) TBD
      - Handing out superlatives and giving a statuette to winners
    - Suggestion to have Sign Gypsy sign outside of Mansfeld for that night. K. Mosconi suggested starting with a budget and adjusting planning from there.

- Other Activities
  - May 18<sup>th</sup>, promotion practice (cafeteria) with yearbook signing time
  - May 19<sup>th</sup>, celebration at school (outdoor and indoor options). Each teacher will supervise a group for 2 period blocks
