

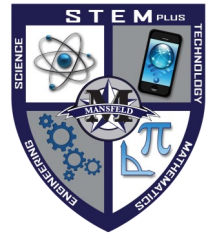

Verizon iPad Information

As a Verizon Innovative Learning School (VILS), our students are provided with iPads and data plans while they attend Mansfeld. In order to receive a device, students and their guardians must first [complete the iPad paperwork linked here](#).

Once a student receives their device and logs in, they will have access to our Manager app. Manager is our district-approved version of the App Store. Students can use Manager to download new apps to their device that their teachers request by pressing the "reinstall/update" button underneath an app of their choice.

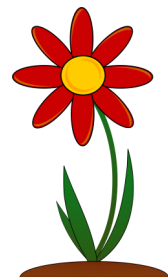


No School on Thursday, August 26 for District PD
